The ESOL Program provides English classes to non-native English-speaking adults to prepare them for college classes, better jobs, and deeper involvement in the Austin community.

Students can make fast progress toward their goals by focusing on the skills they need most. We offer courses in:

- Reading and Vocabulary
- Oral Communication
- Grammar
- Writing
- Electives: Advanced Pronunciation, and Business Communication.

Students can choose one course per semester or, in our most intensive option, up to eight.

ESOL tuition is \$255/course for most students. Students must also purchase textbooks. Financial aid is available to students who qualify.

ESOL PLACEMENT TESTING

Before they register for a class, all new ESOL students must complete the ESOL Assessment, a placement test that will give students their correct level for each of the ESOL skills classes (Oral Communication, Reading and Vocabulary, Grammar, and Writing).

Step 1: Oral Interview

Register for an oral interview appointment at *calendly.com/esol-acc*

Attend the appointment before you begin Step 2.

Step 3: Advising Appointment

Register for an ESOL advising appointment at *calendly.com/esol-acc.* At the appointment, the assessor will explain your test scores, placement levels and how to register.

Step 2: Take the ESOL Assessment

- Visit a Testing Center at a campus near you during their open hours. Testing Center Directions and Schedules are found at *tinyurl.com/acc-test-schedule*
- All testing is on a walk-in basis. There are no appointments.

- a photo ID (ex. passport, driver's license)
- your ACCeID number


